The Joshua Palke Scholarship Fund was created to honor Josh Palke. Josh loved the outdoors. He was only 14 years old when he was tragically killed in a four-wheeling accident in June of 2002. He loved snowmobiling, skiing, four wheeling, running and playing golf. While he preferred to be outdoors, he also excelled at school and played trumpet and piano.

The Palke family set up this scholarship fund to honor Joshua's memory and to support students who exemplify character. The scholarship fund will benefit young adults in their desire to attain a secondary education.

Scholarship Details

Award Amount: One scholarship of \$2,000 and four scholarships of \$1,000 will be available this year.

GPA: 2.5 or better

Planning to attend: Two or four year post-secondary institution. (full-time enrollment)

 - o Current Transcript: Student must obtain their transcript and submit it with all other items.

Notification and Claim Process:

- High School will notify recipients.
- Scholarship agreement and other info due by June15th to CommunityGiving.
- Full-time college enrollment is required.
- Payment will be made to the college by September 1.
- Scholarship will be applied 50 percent for fall semester and 50 percent for spring semester.
